



DAK's Super 36dB Active Noise Canceling Earbuds

Quick Start Guide

Dear Fellow DAKonian,

Thank you for ordering **DAK's Super 36dB Active Noise Canceling Earbuds**. You'll be blown away like I was by how much ambient noise is cut out from loud, noisy environments. Planes, trains and buses are no match for your newfound noise canceling abilities!

OK, I know you've used earbuds hundreds of times, and **you probably won't need to read any of this**. But just to be safe, let's quickly review how these earbuds work so we're all on the same page.

Charging up your ANC Earbuds

Inside the box, you'll find a short charging cable. The Micro USB tip plugs right into the side of the active noise cancellation box. The larger USB end can be plugged into your computer or into a wall plug with a USB input.

It takes two hours to complete the charge cycle, and you'll see the red LED charging light turn green when the battery is full.

A full battery will last you up to 18 hours.

Choosing the correct cushion size

You'll find the medium sized cushions are already fixed onto the earbuds right out of the box.

Try them on to see if it's the right size for you.

You'll see L or R etched on either earbud, but I find it easier to remember that the earhooks need to face forward. They're contoured for your ear shape.

It's really important to get a secure fit, otherwise, the active noise cancellation won't work effectively.

Inserting the earbuds into your ears

It's just like any other earbud you've used before, with one extra step.

Fit the earbud into your ear as you normally would. Then simply press the earhook so that it comfortably tucks away into the flap of your ear.

Using Your Active Noise Cancellation Earbuds without music or without power

Your A.N.C. earbuds will still actively cancel noise even if you haven't plugged the 3.5mm jack into an audio source.

All you need to do is power it up. The blue LED light lets you know that it's working.

Conversely, you can listen to your music even when the A.N.C. is powered off. Your music won't be as amplified, and the bass isn't as pronounced, but you'll still hear everything.
