



DAK's Smartphone Memory Saver 2.0 32GB/64GB

Quick Start Guide

Dear Fellow DAKonian,

Thanks for ordering DAK's Smartphone Memory Saver 2.0. You'll love having the ability to back up your files wherever and whenever is convenient for you as much as I do.

Let's get you started on transferring your files.

iPhone users continue here:

Upon inserting your Memory Saver into your iPhone a you'll be prompted with a notification to install a free file managing app.

Tap the **App Store** button and you'll be taken to the **iDiskk** app.

Download the app and open it up. The first time, you'll be prompted to allow the app to communicate with the iDiskk. That's fine. Allow.

You'll see a toolbar on the bottom of the screen. two circles on the main screen, one says **iPhone** and the other says **My Drive**. These tell you how much storage is being used on each of these devices.

Tap on **My Drive** to access your SD Card.

Move files from your iPhone to your SD card

Tap **My Drive**

Tap the **+** button on the bottom left

Select From Library

You'll be prompted to allow i-Easydrive to access your photos. Tap **OK**

Choose which photos and videos you'd like to copy to your SD Card

Tap **Done**

Type C and Micro USB users continue here:

Transferring Files Between your Android and Memory Saver

We have it so much easier than iPhone users. No special app is needed to access the files on your drive. It's the same concept of plugging in a flash drive and exploring your files, only from your phone.

Newer devices and updated Android operating systems should automatically open up your file explorer when you plug the Memory Saver into your device.

If not, no worries- just find your file explorer (usually a folder called **My Files**) and you've got full access to the files on your Memory Saver

Select the files you want to copy or move, choose your target destination, and you're all set!

Tip: If you tap and hold to highlight a file, you can move your finger up or down to continue highlighting multiple files.

How to copy/move files from an SD Card to an iPhone

Click the My Drive circle

Select the Edit button on the top right



Select which files you want to move or copy to your iPhone

When copying photos to your iPhone's Gallery-

Tap  and then select **Save Images**

You'll now be able to view your saved images in your Photos library

When copying videos and other files

Tap  to move your files or tap  to copy them

Select **iPhone**

Select **Paste to Here**

Your files will now be copied to your iPhone

Tap **Done**

You now have full access to your files through the app by selecting the **iPhone** circle on the app's main screen

Did you know?

You can create full music playlists on your iPhone without ever using iTunes! Play mp3 files directly from the DAK.com Storage app, whether it's being stored on your Memory Saver or on your iPhone.

You can even create playlists by placing your desired tracks into a separate folder in the app.
