



## DAK's Powerbank & Docking Station

### Quick Start Guide

Dear Fellow DAKonian,

Thanks for ordering DAK's DAK's Powerbank & Docking Station. Gone are the days where you can't find your powerbank. From today onward, backup power is always charged and at the ready. Here are some pointers I hope will help you get the most out of your new powerbanks.

#### **Out of the Box Setup**

Plug the included Micro USB cable into the charging input on the side of the charging base. Plug the USB side into a power source—either your computer or a USB wall adapter.

When you dock your powerbanks onto the charging base, you'll see the LED meter glow. Notice the meter indicates the battery level. Once it reaches 100% charge, the status indicator will remain steady and fully lit.

#### **Variables Affecting Charge Time**

Charging up from 0-100% can take between 2-4 hours. I'll explain some of the variables at play so you can maximize the charge speed based on what you need.

The main factor is the wall adapter you've plugged into. What's the wall adapters power output? If it's between 2-3 Amps (Original Android/iPhone/iPad chargers are rated 2.4 Amps), you're in good shape. If your charger is only rated 1 Amp output, it'll take more time to charge up your powerbank.

The other difference is if both docked powerbanks need the recharge. The charging base will split the available power to charge both powerbanks evenly, which means it will take longer to get them both to max capacity. If one of the powerbanks is already fully charged, it won't slow down the other powerbank.

#### **Charging Up Without the Charging Base**

You'll notice a Micro USB input on the powerbank's bottom panel. If you're away from the charging base and need to recharge your powerbank, simply plug it in to a power source with a standard Micro USB cable.

#### **Best Spot For Your Charging Base?**

I'd recommend leaving the charging base somewhere near the front door, right where you leave your keys. You'll love grabbing a pre-charged powerbank just as you're heading out for the day.

I don't have a convenient wall outlet by my front door, so I had to choose between the kitchen countertop or my night table. I chose night table because I like to read and watch movies on my phone at night. Before, when I was tethered to the wall with a cord that was just long enough to be too short. I'd be stuck watching in a single position, and my back always cramped up.

Now that I use my handy dandy powerbank, I find my perfect position every time.
